- 2. If relevant, diplomas from other relevant institutions/programmes of study, from higher education only.
- 3. A project description of 5–11 pages, including topic, research questions, choice of methods, schedule for the completion of the programme and, if relevant, a list of references.
- 4. Information about when and by whom the project has been peer reviewed.
- 5. A list of publications, if relevant (not including second degree theses, master's theses, independent assignments).
- 6. Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- 7. Documentation of researcher training funding.
- 8. Documentation of any previous courses that you wish to have approved on admission. (Transcript of grades and course description with list of references)
- 9. Confirmation of identity (copy of passport or similar, possibly confirmation of name change).
- 10. If relevant, any approvals from ethical committees etc.



- 11. A written confirmation from the proposed main supervisor that the ethical and privacy issues have been resolved in the PhD project, including a reference to the case number from REK, NSD and/or data protection officer
- 12. Operating budget (a concise overview of what it costs to carry out the project). Salary costs shall not be included.
- 13. Data management plan (if this plan is not ready at the time of application, it must be submitted no later than three months after admission)
- 14. ROS analysis (if this analysis is not ready at the time of application, it must be submitted no later than three months after admission).
