

OsloMet – Oslo Metropolitan University

Form of organization and financing.

OsloMet - Oslo Metropolitan University (OsloMet – storbyuniversitetet) is a state university under the Ministry of Education and Research. The university receives annual allocations over the national budget and has its liquid holdings placed in Norges Bank (the central bank of Norway). Of its total turnover of NOK 3,38 billion in 2022, the university received NOK 2,81 billion in allocations from the Norwegian state.

It is not possible to obtain a credit rating of the university as it is part of the Norwegian state.

Neither is it possible to extract directly from the university's accounts the ratio of R&D activity to total turnover, but the university assesses this to account for approximately 36 %.

We enclose approved financial statements for the last three years (2020, 2021 and 2022) in all applications for R&D projects. Approved Auditor's reports for the same statements can also be provided. The accounts of the university are audited by the Office of the Auditor General (Riksrevisjonen).
